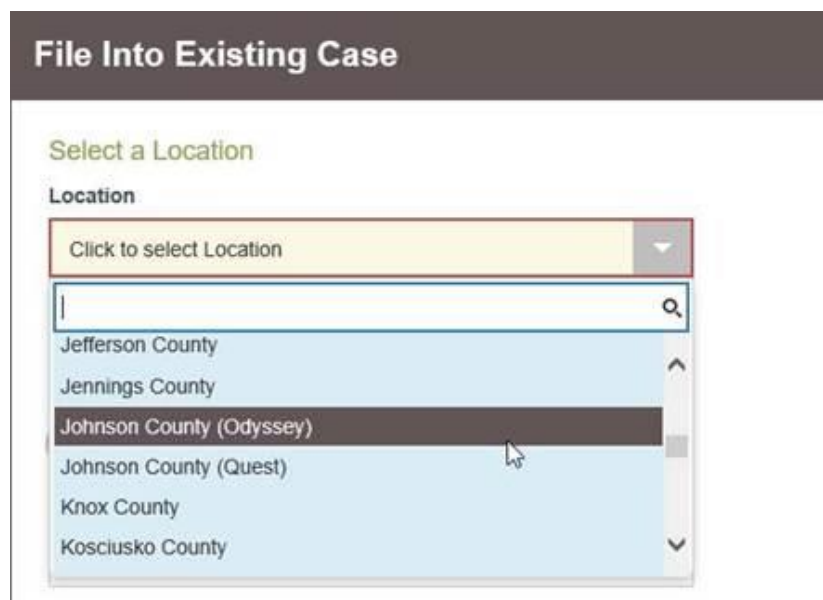
Allen County will soon allow e-filing for the following case types:

1. JC – Juvenile Child in Need of Services (Juvenile CHINS)
2. JD – Juvenile Delinquency
3. JM – Juvenile Miscellaneous
4. JP – Juvenile Paternity
5. JS – Juvenile Status
6. JT – Juvenile Termination of Parental Rights
7. RS – Reciprocal Support

E-filing for these case types will become voluntary for attorneys on December 3, 2018. E-filing for these case types will become mandatory for attorneys on February 4, 2019.

The aforementioned case types are handled in the Court’s Quest case management system – not the Odyssey system. When e-filing into Allen County’s Courts on December 3, the e-filer will need to choose between *Allen County (Quest)* or *Allen County (Odyssey)* to select the proper case type within their e-filing service provider.

For the case types listed above, select *Allen County (Quest)* when e-filing. For all other case types, select *Allen County (Odyssey)* when e-filing. The screenshot below shows an existing example of this step regarding Johnson County.
